SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Proclamation of October as Home & Community Education Month- An Exhibit which has been in existence for 91 years will be on display at the Gail Borden Library through October.

Over 40 residents were in attendance to discuss the flooding that occurred in their neighborhoods within the last week. Most were from the area that is Cook County and along Poplar Creek. Trees for years had fallen along the banks, debris was in the creek for years - these concerns were not addressed in the past. Council assured the residents that this matter was of the highest concern and would be addressed.

A representative of the neighborhood organization ONE, again stated that police pick & choose who they stop and are looking for the Police Chief to discipline the offending officers.
